A little bit of history

The Lamb Inn in Old Town, Eastbourne is one of the oldest pubs in England. Steeped in history with cellars and a crypt beneath the public bar, the building dates back to 1180 and has close links to the neighbouring Norman church and numerous ecclesiastical links with local monastic orders.

Originally built as a clergy house as part of the development of the church, then called St Michael's, the Lamb would have housed the clergy, and during its early life in 1180/90 six to twelve monks or clergymen would have lived here, providing alms to the people of Eastbourne who came for handouts.

Other historical links include its theatrical past and the productions that took place in the assembly rooms, most notably the amateur dramatic productions hosted by Augustus Egg and Charles Dickens.

Other ancient features include a 60ft well, gargoyles and a superb original fireplace. Cellar tours are available by appointment.
